

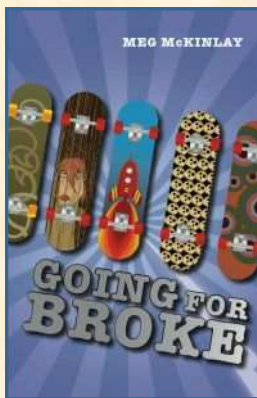
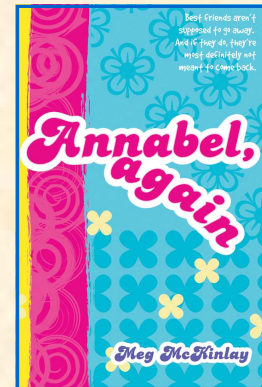

CHILDREN'S WRITER AND POET

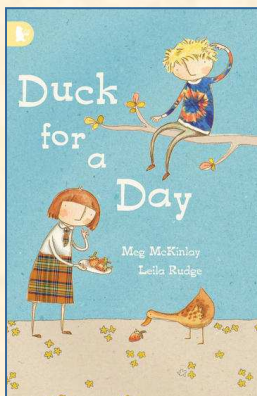


◆ Meg is a West Australian writer of poetry and fiction. Her children's writing ranges from picture books through to young adult novels.

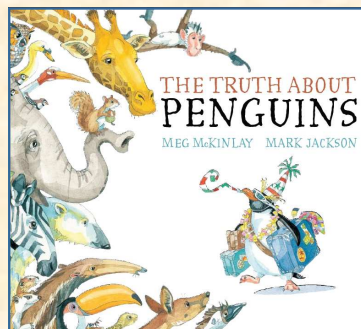

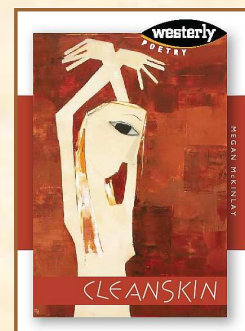


◆ *Duck for a Day* is an illustrated chapter book for ages 7-9. What would you do to bring the class duck home?
